A few days ago, I learned of the death of Fr. Duane Jack, who was a co-pastor at Sacred Heart in the 1970's. His funeral was at Christ the King Catholic Church in Moline. I have known Fr. Jack since I was in grade school. His first assignment was in Kewanee. He grew up in the Quad Cities, he went to Alleman Catholic High School, and he spent most of the rest of his life serving in our area. He is probably best known for being the Cursillo Program's spiritual director. He helped thousands of people to grow closer to Christ over almost fifty years. He did as much if not more than any priest in the area to evangelize others.

Fr. Jack was very humble and unpretentious. His ministry was never about him. He served the Lord with all his energy. He was never in robust health, but he continued to minister until shortly before his death. He was a priest we all could depend on. He did not vacation too much but found his joy in being present when people needed him. His love of the Lord was evident to all.

We pray for Fr. Jack for his family, and all who mourn his passing.

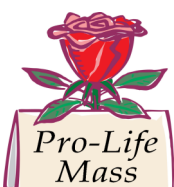

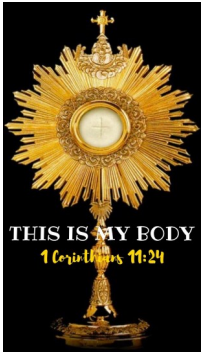

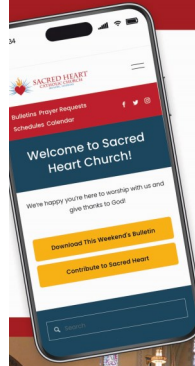
