



Dear Friends.

Pause with me to do a little "heart check" right now. Take a few moments to reflect on these questions: What weighs on your heart, perhaps causing you pain, anger, sorrow or frustration? What delights your heart, bringing you joy, peace, excitement or happiness? What pulls your heart into deeper wondering and reflection? Finally, to whom do you go to share these movements of your heart?

Many people, it seems, find it hard to share with others what is in their hearts. Perhaps a deep reason behind this is a fear we all have in common: vulnerability. Whom can I trust with the joys, sorrows and secrets of my heart? As we journey through life, the Lord will often help us discover that trustworthy person in a family member or close friend. But all along this pilgrimage to Heaven, there is only One who is always trustworthy and absolutely steadfast, and His name is Jesus.

As we recall the Presentation of the Lord and Simeon's declaration that the infant Jesus is light for the nations and the glory of Israel (Lk 2:32), the Church celebrates World Day of Consecrated Life. As a religious sister, I find this day an opportunity for gratitude and reflection as I consider the great gift of grace God has given me in my vocational state in life. Yet, like all vocations in the Church, my vocation is not for me alone! It is meant to help build up the Body of Christ. Whether it is through bringing young people to encounter Jesus in the Eucharist ("Transforming encounter"), teaching about the great mysteries of our faith ("St. Thomas Aguinas on the Eucharist"), using creativity to share the Gospel ("Revive!" Podcast) or other apostolic works like caring for the poor and the suffering, consecrated men and women across the ages have been entrusted with a precious task: to help the Church keep her eyes upon the one thing necessary, our Savior Jesus.

As we consider the centrality of Jesus for all of us today, I'm also very grateful to share a reflection from Archbishop Timothy P. Broglio on the Eucharist. This is the first in a new series of videos from our bishops, in which they share their personal and pastoral experiences of our Eucharistic Lord. Finally, don't miss Father Luke's latest column as he continues to take us step-by-step through the Mass.

Let's pray for one another as we prepare to enter into the Holy Season of Lent a profound opportunity for Eucharistic Renewal Jesus is offering to each and every one of us!
