

On March 24th we begin Holy Week. This is a week where we celebrate the apex of the liturgical year. We begin with Palm Sunday. The highlight of Palm Sunday is the procession into the church and the reading of The Passion of Jesus Christ according to Matthew. Since

we read this scripture, this day is often referred to as Passion Sunday. We will have outside processions at 4:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday and on Sunday at 11:00 a.m. Mass. We leave in silence. For some, the next time they come to Mass will be Easter Sunday. The silence reminds them to live life prayerfully during Holy Week.

Many of us will celebrate the Easter Triduum. This begins on Holy Thursday with the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 p.m.. We remember at this liturgy the beginnings of the Christian Eucharist. This liturgy is a very touching one. It ends with a procession around the church after which the consecrated hosts are placed in the altar of repose. Adoration takes place until midnight.

The next day is Good Friday. At 3:00 p.m. we have the Commemoration of the Lord's Passion. We read the Gospel Story in parts, have adoration of the cross and receive communion. This is a solemn celebration where we are reminded of the cost of discipleship.

We round out the Triduum with the Easter Vigil beginning at 7:30 p.m.. We will have 13 parishioners of various ages celebrating the sacraments of initiation. We begin with the lighting of the Easter fire. This is one of the most beautiful liturgies of the Church Year. If a person takes time to attend these liturgies it is a reminder of what we believe as Christians. Usually, it becomes a spiritual practice that is carried over from year to year.

I hope to see many of you at the liturgies during Holy Week.

In Sister Kathleen's name, we would like to continue the tradition


