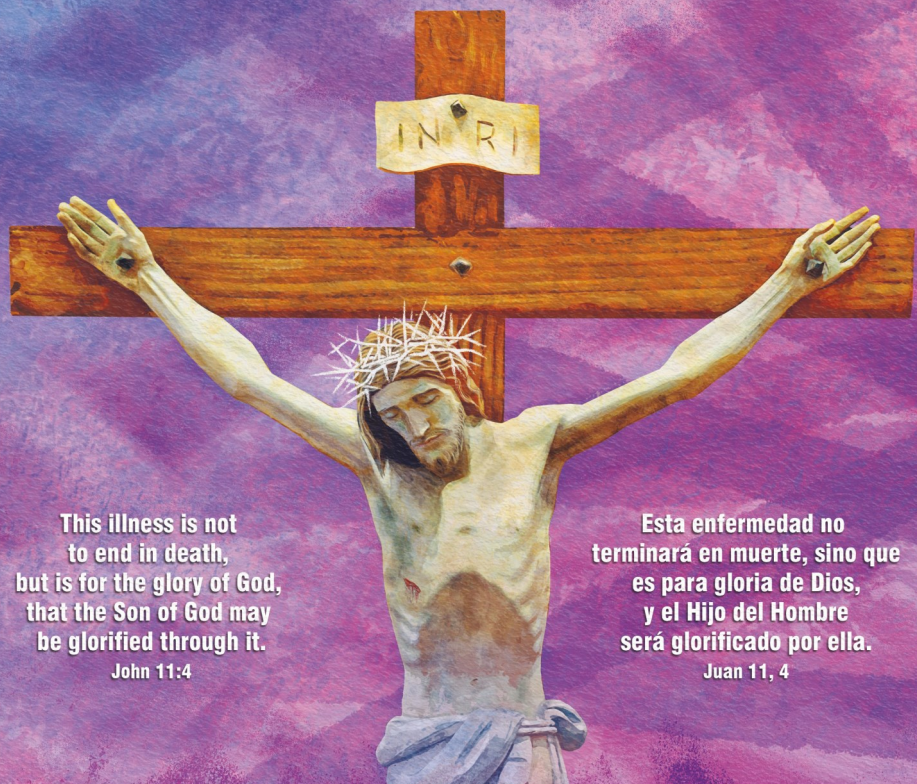

Dear Parishioners,

Palm Sunday will be next weekend. This marks the beginning of Holy Week. One of the traditions of Holy Week is that we have a procession into the church after we bless the palms. We will start the service in the Memorial Garden weather permitting and walk down the sidewalk on 17th Avenue to the front door. If there is foul weather we now have the option of beginning in our Gathering Space. Please be alert when you arrive at church.

Holy Week is the apex of the liturgical year. We celebrate the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday). These are usually inspiring liturgies that remind us of the core Theology of our faith. We call this the Paschal mystery. Jesus died rose again to new life. His experience can be our experience.

The Christian life is a life of paradox. The Hosannas of Palm Sunday give way to the words Crucify him on Good Friday. Jesus endured the humiliation of the cross. He did it out of love for us. The suffering was necessary so that resurrection could happen. The Easter message is one of hope. That hope is what sustains us as we endure the trials of our life. I would encourage everyone to participate in the Holy Week Services. I use the word participate deliberately. The liturgies offer many opportunities to unite with Jesus in the experience of the Paschal Mystery.

May Our Lady pray for us as Holy Week approaches.

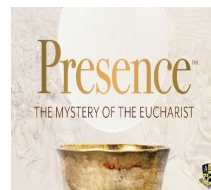

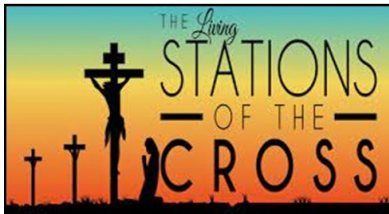
