

As you can see, our Sunday Collections have increased from this time last year. We received an Estate and Bequest which totaled \$105,370.00 which in large part consisted of a house that we were able to sell. We have also received many gifts with the Offertory Commitments. Thank you for your generosity! It helps tremendously.

Expenses:

Expenses have been a little less than budgeted in some areas and a little higher than budgeted in others. We were hoping to exceed our ADA goal this year and we almost met it. We are currently short of the goal by \$852.00.

We are also paying down our debt for the St. Damien Center. We currently owe \$264,000.00 on the loan. Thanks to your continued generosity we have been able to make significant strides toward reducing the debt.

Thank you again for your generosity and continued support to the Parish. We would encourage all who may have fallen behind in their offertory donations to make those donations.




