Totus Tuus

It's registration time for Totus Tuus at St. Anne! Totus Tuus is a Latin phrase that means "totally yours", a motto given to us by Saint John Paul II in describing his dedication to Jesus through Mary. During one week this summer, July 9 through 14, we will provide Catholic children entering grades one through twelve, a prayer filled environment that will help them become closer to Christ through His Mother, Mary. This program combines fun with faith filled experiences, including daily Mass for the Day Program. A creative and enthusiastic team of young adults from the Diocese of Peoria will help youth come to know and devote themselves to Mary, Our Mother. In 2023, Totus Tuus will focus on the Mysteries of Salvation and the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary.
