Last week it was announced that Fr. Daniel Mirabelli retired as head of the Development Office at Alleman High School. He was a teacher and staff member for over 50 years. He taught sociology in his early years at Alleman and then started his fundraising career. Fr. Mirabelli

presided at a Sunday Mass here at Sacred Heart for many years, so our parish is very familiar to him.

Any graduate of Alleman since the 1960's has a Fr. Mirabelli story. His life was tied up with the history of Alleman. He is especially well known by student athletes who graduated from Alleman. He was chaplain for many teams.

He developed the fundraising arm of Alleman and raised millions of dollars. He became the ambassador for Alleman in the Quad City community. He is best remembered for the religious influence he had on many young people. He presided at many baptisms, weddings and funerals through the years.

I am not sure what Fr. Mirabelli's plans are, but at 91 he deserves to enjoy a well-deserved rest. We will miss him and pray that he enjoys some happy years with all his friends. I have known Father for 40 years and admired his dedication to Christ and his church. Perhaps he will be able to visit Sacred Heart at times in the future.

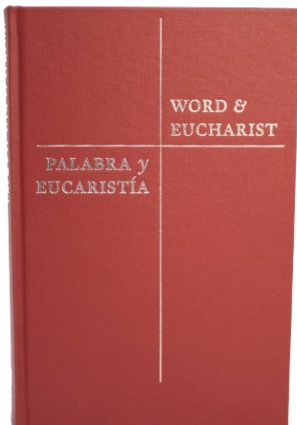

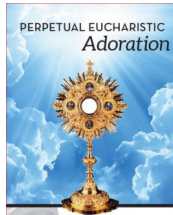

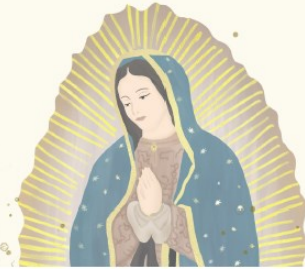
