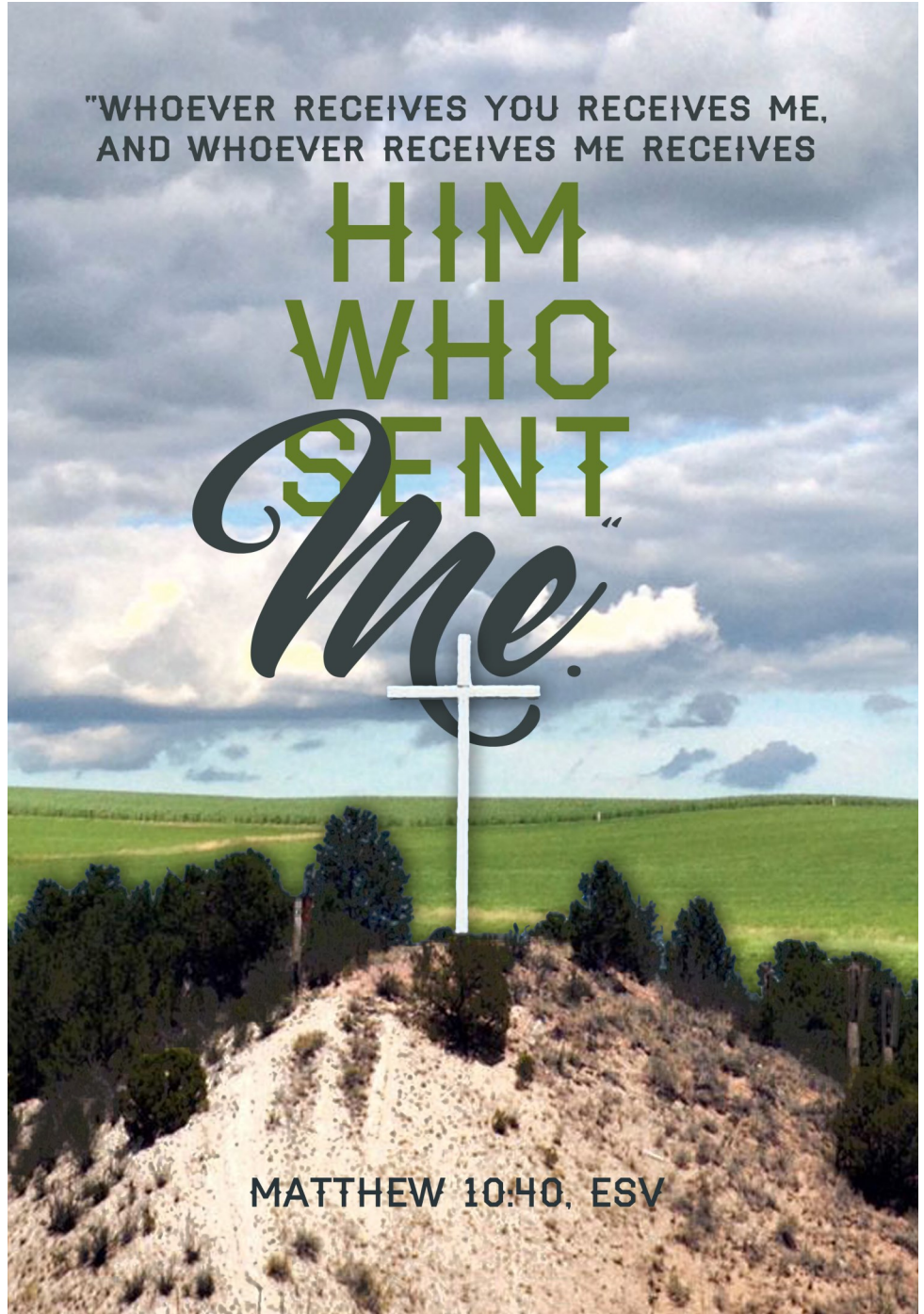

Send your kids On An Out-Of-This-World Adventure!

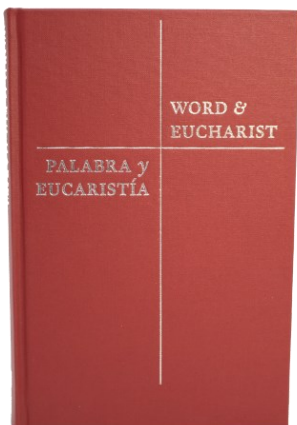

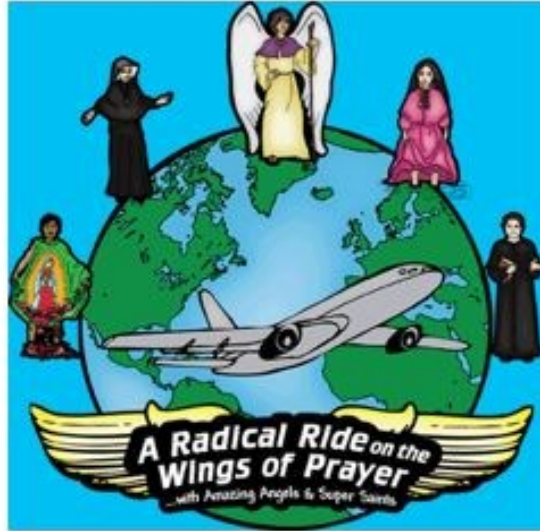
