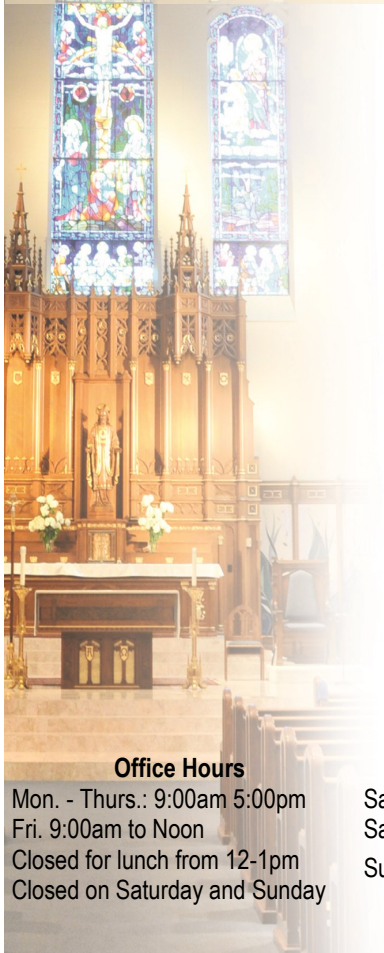

Dear Parishioners,

Our finance committee recently reviewed our finances since it is the end of the fiscal year. There was a lot there to reflect on. It was a good year in many ways. Our Centennial Campaign collected over \$300,000 which allowed us to make progress on the debt we incurred because of our new addition. We have a mountain to climb, but it is a lot smaller because of people's generosity. We continue to receive gifts.

Our operating expenses had a mixed bag of news. The good news is that our collections were up slightly for the year after several years of decline. We did not achieve the budget for collections but over the last few months we collected more than the year before. This is a positive sign.

We were able to meet our operating budget because we received monies from a couple of estates. We are thankful for that, and I will share more information about that in our year end report in October. If you can include Sacred Heart in your estate planning that will help the parish. A simple thing like leaving the remnant of your estate can make a huge impact.

God continues to bless our parish. For this we are thankful.

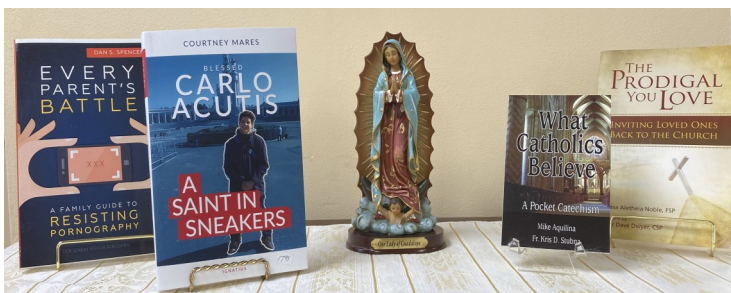
A Vacation Bible School Thank You
