Dear Parishioners,

Parking around the church is going to be a little more challenging in the weeks to come. We are presently negotiating with the city so that we might keep an open lane on 17th Avenue. We are going to be erecting fencing that will keep children from straying into truck traffic. The staging area for the building is where the playground normally is for

Seton School. The grade school playground will be limited to the parking lot north of the church between the Lee Parish Center and the grade school. The Middle School Students will play outside on 17th Avenue. The street will be blocked. All this is being negotiated with the city of Moline.

The good news is that a lot of activity will be happening over the next few weeks. Walls and trusses will be brought to the building site and our new addition will start taking shape.

The other piece of good news is that 17th Avenue should now drain properly in front of the Middle School, especially in the wintertime when there is snow. This has been an ongoing problem and a safety hazard.

Let's continue to ask St. Damien to intercede for those who are working on our building and for those who are doing the planning. He is the patron of our building project.

May Our Lady watch over us and bring healing to our troubled country.

We would like to share information from our operating budget from July 1, 2021, to June 30, 2022. We stopped putting weekly updates in our bulletin concerning collections during the pandemic. The value of listing collections week to week did not seem to have much impact on donations to the offertory. We hope that a more comprehensive report that will be given quarterly or more often, might help parishioners understand our needs.

As you can see, our Sunday Collections have minimally increased over last year. We also received an additional \$61,000 for PPP that we will probably not receive again. Without the PPP (Paycheck Protection Program) money we would have been significantly lower. And without the generous faithful contributions from you our debt would be higher, so thank you.

Our expenses have increased as everyone's has. Our expenses were \$146,445.00 over income. This is mostly due to regular parish activities resuming after the pandemic, rising fuel and supply costs, utility bills, etc.

In addition to our operating expenses there are projects that could not be delayed that helped keep Sacred Heart safe and in good repair, such as a new roof on Culemans Hall that stopped extensive water damage, resurfacing the old back parking lot, repairing the gutters on the church to stop leakage, and plastering and wall repair in the Church as well as the step repair at the Church entrance. These projects cost an additional \$132,270.00. Without including these capital projects our loss for the year in the normal operating budget would have been \$14,145.00

Overall, the PPP money and organizations like Birdies for Charity greatly helped this year. If you look at our contributions this year vs. last year we increased by \$505.00. However, overall income decreased by \$17,839.00 while expenses increased \$358,607.00 over last year. We would encourage all who may have fallen behind in their offertory donations to make those donations.

We will have our yearly financial report in our October *Heartbeat* newsletter. We will include a detailed report on our successful TTT campaign and information on our other assets like our endowment fund. The information included in the bulletin today is to keep everyone apprised of the state of our normal operating budget. We choose to report these numbers quarterly so that we might give more information than a simple look at weekly offertory collections.
