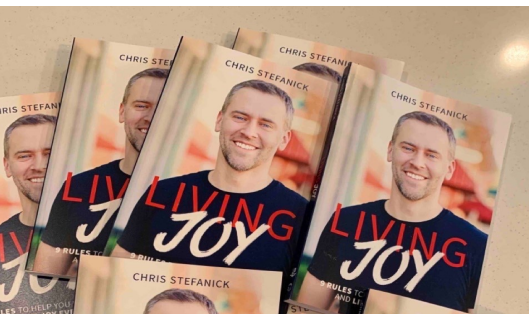

2022 Annual Diocesan Appeal

Next weekend, Sacred Heart will participate in the **Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA)** for the Diocese of Peoria. **NEW THIS YEAR:** Pledge cards will not be distributed in our church. Fr. Mark has sent a letter to each parishioner explaining the changes. Each household will also receive a mailing from Bishop Tylka which includes a newsletter, a prayer request, a personalized pledge card and a return envelope. Fill out the pledge card and a prayer request if you wish and mail it directly to the Diocese of Peoria.

Our assigned goal this year is \$124,349. This is \$9,000 over our goal last year. Any money that we receive over our parish goal is returned to Sacred Heart for our own programs. If we do not meet our goal, the balance is taken from our regular donations. As followers of Christ, we are called to respond to God's grace in our lives and to serve one another. The Annual Diocesan Appeal is an opportunity to respond to His grace by sharing our gifts and so transform lives throughout the diocese. Please give generously as God has given to you.
