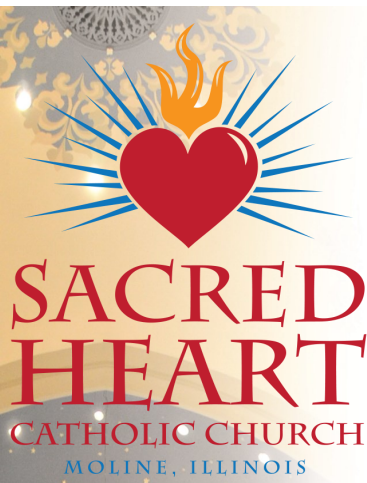

Dear Parishioners,

September 9th and 10th the Diocese of Peoria is having its annual appeal. Each year the parishes have a fund drive that raises money for the various ministries of the diocese. We are assessed a certain amount of money. This year our goal is \$105,000. This is lower than last year's goal of almost \$125,000. We might ask why this is the case. It is because the percentage of monies we contribute to Catholic Schools has gone over 50% of our ordinary income. When that happens, we pay less to the diocese.

It would be great to meet our goal. If we fall short, we must make up the difference from our ordinary income. If we exceed the goal, we receive a rebate. If we do receive a rebate the finance committee has decided to put the excess toward debt reduction. Also, if we receive a rebate, it is not counted as ordinary income.

Can you help us out? Many of you received a mailing from the diocese. Please fill out that pledge card and mail it back. If you did not receive a pledge card, please pick one up from the pew and mail it back or put it in the collection.

We made great progress meeting our ADA goal in the last few years. Let us continue to be generous so the diocese can fund the needs of seminarians and deacons, and have the funds needed to expand its other ministries.

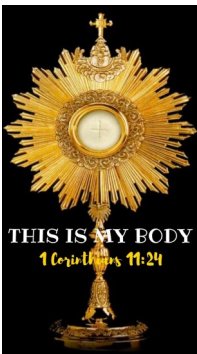
