Dear Parishioners,

During this month, we honored all those who died as we celebrated All Souls Day and All Saints Day. Funerals, burials and other customs revolving around death and grieving are changing rapidly. People ask me all the time what the church teaches.

There is a church liturgy we follow for funerals. It involves three parts. The first part of the liturgy involves a wake. At the wake there are usually prayers. This can be a rosary or a wake service. This is a wonderful way to remember a person's life of faith in this world. The second part of the funeral is either a Mass in church or a prayer service at the funeral home. Finally, there is the interment at the cemetery. These three steps all help with the grieving process.

Sometimes it seems like the faith of the person who died is forgotten. All or parts of the funeral are dropped. We must remember that the liturgy of the church has many graces. We are reminded that death is not the end, but we anticipate resurrection. A funeral is both sad and hopeful at the same time. We express the emotions we feel and what we believe about death through the prayer we share.

If you have questions about funeral practices call Fr. Matthew or me and we would be glad to offer counsel to you. We try to be very sensitive to the families who come to us in their grief.

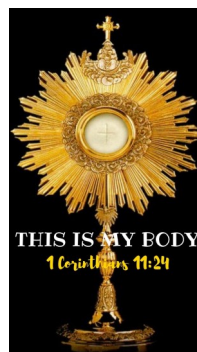

IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER

Individuals age 72 and older can make distributions from \$1 up to \$100,000 a year to non-profit (501c3) organizations, such as your parish, Catholic school and diocese, directly through their IRA at any time. The government requires a certain amount be taken out of the IRA each year and that amount is subject to federal tax. However, **qualified gifts are tax free and can count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD)**, resulting in a distinct tax advantage. Contact the custodian of your IRA for a list of the necessary steps.



Parishes across the Diocese of Peoria completed their parish meetings for Growing Disciples, the multiyear pastoral planning process for the Catholic Diocese of Peoria to renew discipleship and enhance relationships with Jesus Christ in every corner of our region. Bishop Tylka is reading, listening to, and praying about, all the feedback he received. So far, we received more than 1,000 surveys and emails. Your input is needed and valued as he discerns the future landscape of the Diocese of Peoria. You have until November 22, to provide

feedback on the second draft of proposed parish models by going to growingdisciplescdop.org. The next step is for the Core Team to incorporate the views of the priests and laity and prayerfully discern a final set of parish models to present to the Pastoral Planning Commission for their input. The Diocese of Peoria is constantly updating the website, so check back frequently. Please continue to pray that all our efforts today bear fruit for a brighter tomorrow.

Are You A Registered Parishioner?

Sacred Heart tries to make registering as a parish member an easy process. Many believe that if they attend Mass here at Sacred Heart that they are a registered member of the parish. Are you on our mailing list? Do you receive envelopes? If not, it could be quite embarrassing to us, to you and to your family when someone wants to make wedding plans, have a baby baptized, or if you are asked to act as sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation requiring a note of Catholicity from us. 2. You may stop by the Parish Office during our regular office hours to register.
3. You may call the Parish Office at 309-762-2362 to ask for a registration form and we will be happy to mail one to your home or you can pick up a registration form in the pamphlet rack in the front vestibule of the Church.
4. **PARENTS:** If you have children living at home who are 18 years old or older, they need to register in the parish on their own. If you have adult children who are no longer living in the area, please notify us at the parish office 309-762-2362.
5. Also, if you no longer have a land-line phone, please contact the office with your updated cell phone numbers. Thank you.

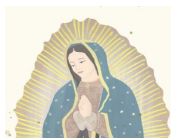
