Our pastoral care ministers take care of our most vulnerable parishioners. We have well over a hundred people who are shut-in or in nursing homes. When a pastor has so many talented people to work with it is tremendous blessing. I often feel like I am just the conductor of the orchestra. If everyone plays their part the result is beautiful.

I invite everyone to thank all the people I wrote about. The staff are underpaid, but they do not complain. Please express your gratitude as the year ends. That uplifts them and lets them know that they are making a difference.

Finally, I want to thank all who support us financially. It takes a tremendous amount of money to fund Sacred Heart's ministries. It is great that so many people want to help. We are totally dependent on your charity.

God gave us the greatest gift, his son Jesus. Jesus came to redeem us, to show us what God's love is like. Jesus set the standard for charity and sacrifice. If we emulate him, our church community will be a place of joy and hope. I pray that everyone says a prayer of gratitude for our parish during the next few days. Hopefully, you feel the presence of Jesus during this holy time.
