We have done significant work to renew the church building the last few years. We have tuckpointed, restored windows, worked on air conditioning, upgraded sound and done a hose of other maintenance. The addition we are building will offer modern amenities that we sorely need. People will be able to come to church who have been unable to do so. There will be space for community building.

Please come to the groundbreaking and enjoy another historical moment in the history of Sacred Heart.

TAKE A LOOK!

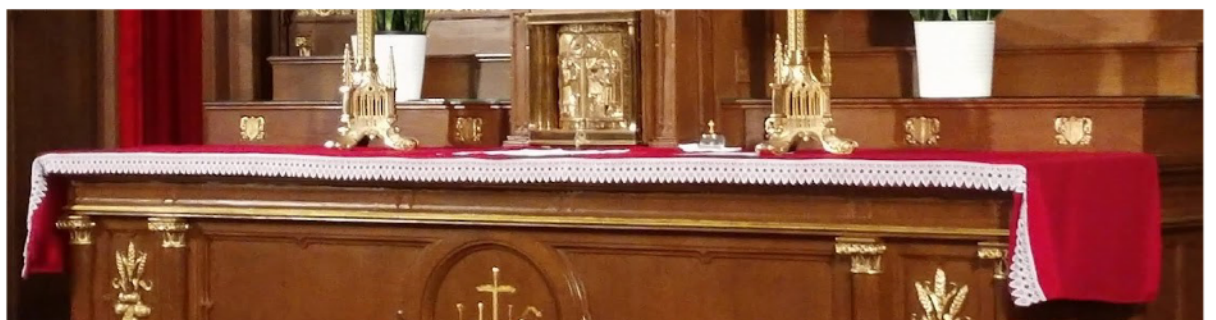
