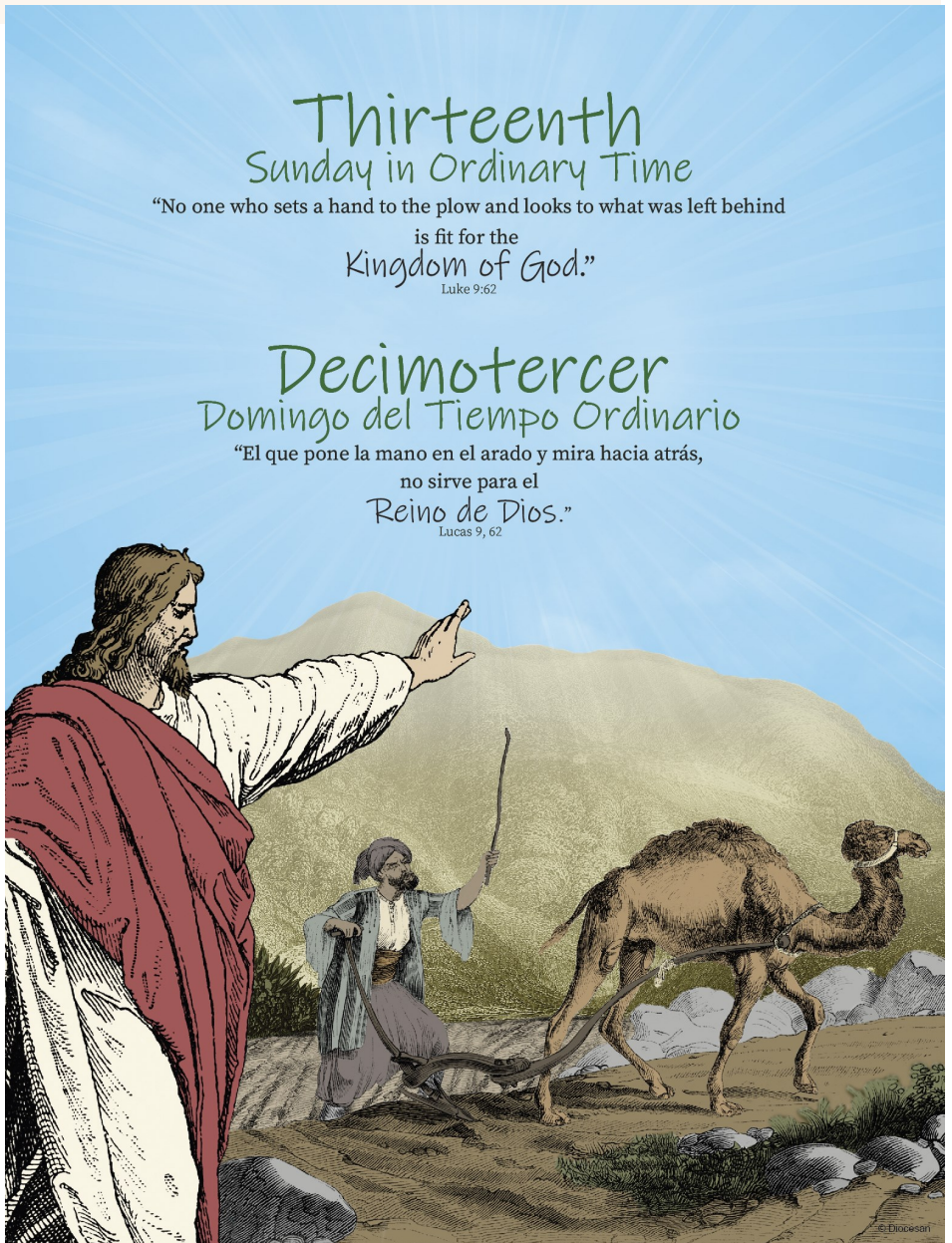

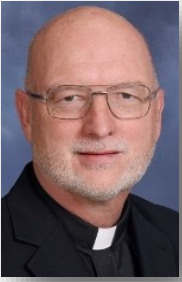

ARE YOU A REGISTERED MEMBER OF SACRED HEART PARISH?

Sacred Heart tries to make registering as a parish member an easy process. Many believe that if they attend Mass here at Sacred Heart that they are a registered member of the parish. If not, it could be quite embarrassing to us, to you and to your family when someone wants to make wedding plans, have a baby baptized, or if you are asked to act as a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation requiring a note of Catholicity from us. If we have no record of your membership, we cannot do this. We provide 4 convenient ways to register here at Sacred Heart. We hope that by listing them below, you will find one of them convenient for you to become a member of Sacred Heart Parish.

5. **PARENTS:** If you have children living at home who are 18 years old or older, they need to register in the parish on their own. If you have adult children who are no longer living in the area, please notify us at the parish office 309-762-2362.

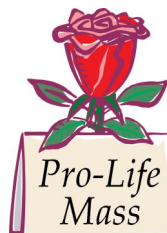

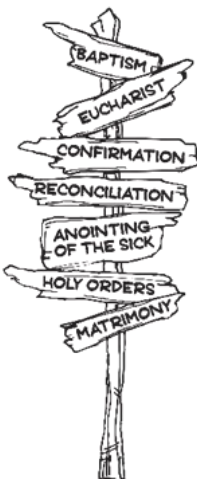
