


Listening Campaign

As we have come to the close of another year of Sacraments it is never too early to think about catching up on Sacraments missed. Our First Holy Communion and Confirmation classes are a 2-year program as outlined by the Diocese of Peoria. First Holy Communion is completed in 2nd grade and for children Confirmation in 8th grade.

RCIC - (Rite of Christian Initiation for Children) is the program used to catch children up who have missed the normal timeframe for Sacraments.

This summer we will begin the first part of the Sacramental program and then students will be ready for their final year of learning when we start back in September with making their Sacraments in the Spring.

This is also a good time to get your children Baptized if life got away from you and your children are older and are in need of their sacraments. Our next Baptismal class is in June 28 at 7:00pm; this must be completed before the Sacrament of Baptism can be planned.
